Driving Instructions from Whistler Village

From Whistler Village, take Highway 99 southbound back towards Vancouver. Turn right off of the highway at the new Callaghan Valley Nordic access road. The turnoff is about 14km from Whistler Village, or about 5 minutes past Function Junction.

Follow the new access road for about 8.5km. You will see a sign on your left. Turn left and cross the bridge over Madeley Creek. Just past the bridge, you will see the driveway to our Alexander Falls base area on your left hand side. This is where we will meet you.

NOTE: Whistler is in the heart of the Coast Mountain Range, and we are famous for our winter storms and abundant snowfalls. While this powder is what makes the skiing here so incredible, it can create difficult driving conditions. **Please be sure that the vehicle you are traveling in is equipped with good winter (snow) tires, and be sure to carry chains.**
